

ORAL PRESENTATION/SPEECH

The Oral Presentation should be memorized or recorded on note cards. It should address the topic thoroughly, stressing all key points and revealing a depth of knowledge. Interesting details or anecdotes should be integrated into drier factual information. Logical organization should be evident. The delivery should have appropriate tone, rate, volume, eye contact and gestures. The student should be able to answer questions which the audience may ask. The minimum delivery time is three minutes.

EXPERT LEVEL: Meets or exceeds all above criteria.

ACCEPTABLE LEVEL: Meets above criteria but weaknesses are apparent in unity, analysis or communication.

NEEDS REVISION: Product is weak in several areas and suggested revisions need to be made in the time period stated.

NO CREDIT: Earned for anything less than the above.
