## Questions to Guide Discussion

### General Questions:

(Require students to give detailed, specific answers.)

1. When was this photograph taken? Where?
2. What do you see in the foreground? Background?
3. What do you see in the upper left quadrant?
4. What do you see in the lower left quadrant?
5. What do you see in the upper right quadrant?
6. What do you see in the lower right quadrant?

### Specific Questions:

1. Who are the two men in the photograph?
2. What are they discussing?
3. The man on the left is President Lincoln, and the man on the right is General George B. McClellan. What could be so urgent that would make the president visit the general where he I encamped rather than having the general come to Washington?

### Title of Photograph:
