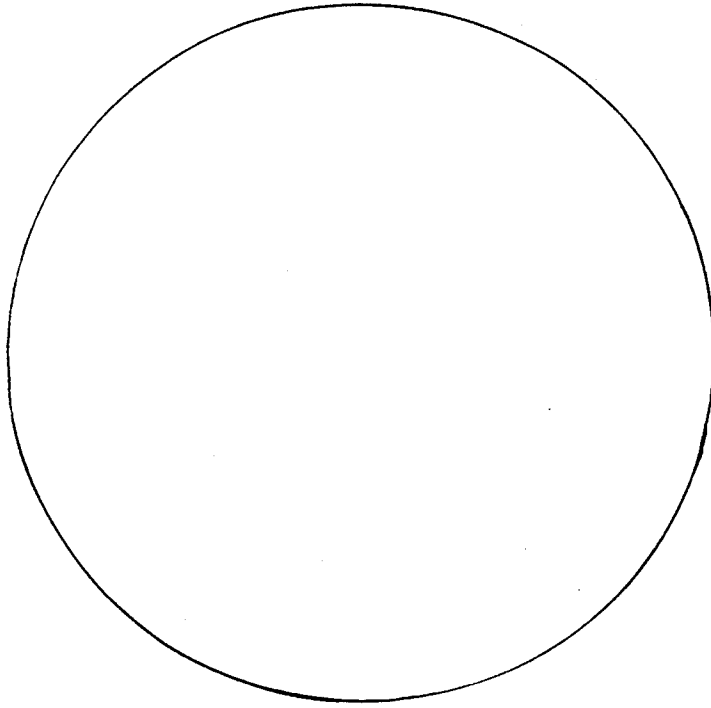
Directions:
